Huntsville Housing Authority Awarded Federal Grants
More than \$500,000 to help promote self-sufficiency

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has awarded the Huntsville Housing Authority two separate grants totaling more than \$500,000 to help support its efforts to promote self-sufficiency programs for residents.

“These are competitive grants and we are proud to have been awarded these funds to continue our efforts to assist our residents move toward self-sufficiency,” said Michael Lundy, the authority’s executive director/CEO.

Under the Resident Opportunities and Self-Sufficiency program, the Huntsville Housing Authority was awarded one grant for \$55,550. The funds will be used to renew a Family Self-Sufficiency Program coordinator position for one year.

Another grant for \$462,000 will be used to fund two supervisory positions - including their training - for three years. The funds are to cover the coordination of self-sufficiency supportive services and other youth activities for residents.
